

# JENKINTOWN BOROUGH COUNCIL PUBLIC MEETING August 24th, 2022

#### **MINUTES**

- 1. Call to Order: President J. Conners called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance: Mayor G. Lerman led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3. Roll Call:
  - <u>Council members present</u>: President J. Conners, Vice President C. Soltysiak, Councilor D. Ballard, Councilor J. Bruno, Councilor A. Narva, Councilor A. MacHaffie, Councilor D. Pancoe, Councilor M. Marlowe, Councilor A. Bartlett, and Councilor A. Khalil.

  - <u>Others Present</u>: Manager G. Locke, Chief T. Scott, Solicitor P. Hitchens, Engineer K. Hassan, and Mayor G. Lerman.
- **4. Approval of Minutes: July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2022:** On motion of President J. Conners, seconded by Councilor M. Marlowe, the motion approving the July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2022 council minutes were approved unanimously.
- 5. Approval of Payrolls dated July 28th and August 11th in the amount of \$194,785.47 and invoices totaling \$196,496.82. On motion of Councilor D. Ballard, seconded by Councilor J. Bruno, the motion approving payrolls dated July 28th and August 11th in the amount of \$194,785.47 and invoices totaling \$196,496.82 were approved unanimously.
- **6. Public Comment:** None at this time.
- **7. Public Hearings –** President J. Conners made a motion, seconded by Councilor J. Bruno, to open the public hearing. The motion passed unanimously. Solicitor P. Hitchens explained the Public hearing policies and procedures prior to the commencement of the hearing itself. A Court Stenographer was in attendance and transcribed the hearing.

Solicitor P. Hitchens gave a brief overview of the Curative Amendment Petition for 111 York and 103 York Road. The applicant challenges the validity of Section 181-141 of the Borough Zoning Ordinance relating to off-premises advertising signs in order to seek revisions to said Ordinance and requesting site specific relief to construct and install a monopole billboard at 103 York Road and 111 York Road.

President J. Conners made a motion, seconded by Vice President C. Soltysiak to go back into the Borough's monthly meeting, and continue with the agenda items listed. The motion passed unanimously.

Administration and Finance: Councilor D. Ballard noted that there was no committee meeting held this
month. Councilor D. Ballard noted that Borough Council has begun setting up the 457 Plan with cBiz. The
457-plan is a pretax savings plan, similar to a 401K however the Borough will not be making contributions
towards the 457 plan.

Bruno, approving payment to G&B Construction Group Inc. in the amount of \$102,166.50 for the Cedar Street Moretti Park Construction as per Pennoni Associates Inc. Engineers recommendation.

- 3. Intergovernmental Cost Sharing Agreement: President J. Conners made a motion, seconded by Councilor D. Pancoe, approving Resolution #2022-27 approving an intermunicipal cost sharing agreement with Abington Township for work to be performed on an 18" sewer line in the rear of Stewart Avenue and SPS Technologies, which trunk sewer line currently receives and transports flow from both the Jenkintown sanitary sewer system and the Abington sanitary sewer system.
