MINUTES

- 1. Call to Order: President J. Conners called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance: Mayor G. Lerman led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3. Roll Call:

- 4. Public Comment: None at this time.
- **5. Public Hearings –** President J. Conners made a motion, seconded by Councilor A. Khalil, to open the public hearing. The motion passed unanimously. Solicitor P. Hitchens explained the Public hearing policies and procedures prior to the commencement of the hearing itself. A Court Stenographer was in attendance and transcribed the hearing.

Solicitor P. Hitchens gave a brief overview of the Curative Amendment Petition for 111 York and 103 York Road. The applicant challenges the validity of Section 181-141 of the Borough Zoning Ordinance relating to off-premises advertising signs in order to seek revisions to said Ordinance and requesting site specific relief to construct and install a monopole billboard at 103 York Road and 111 York Road.
